

How to use the View Quilts by Quilter Name Functionality

To find quilts created by a person, the best way to get the clearest results is to enter the first name and last name of the person with normal capitalization – i.e., Mary Jones, and then press the search button.

If there are one or more quilts that were created by Mary Jones, then a phrase Filter by related tags will be displayed and a grey button with Mary Jones 's name will be displayed. Beneath that one or more pictures will be displayed. If only one quilt was found the picture may be quite large. If more than one quilt was found, they will be displayed in one or more rows below the grey button filter(s). If no quilts are found matching the full name Mary Jones, but quilts created by someone with the first name of Mary or the last name of Jones are found, then filter tags for the various names will be created and pictures of all the quilts created by someone named Mary ... or Jones.... will be displayed. There is also one last situation that may create some matches that you might not be expecting. If the person not only created quilts but also quilted other people's quilts, then names of the other people will also appear in the filter tag buttons as will pictures of the quilts they worked on for others.

You can click on one of the filter buttons to display quilts from only one quilter. If you want to see all the quilts returned by the initial search. Click on the Clear filters button and you will see all the quilts and all the filters returned by the original search.

The next thing you can do with the pictures of the quilts returned by this search is to look at the pictures in more detail, along with the quilt cap on, winner status of any, and the quilt stories. To do that, click on any of the quilt pictures. A large version of the quilt picture will be displayed with the quilt cap on (quilt hanging number, title, quilt name, quilt dimensions and winner information if the quilt won an award. Below that, the Quilt story will be displayed.

Below the quilt story, a row of icons and small versions of the pictures match the list of pictures displayed on the quilts returned by the selected search. These overlay the bottom of the quilt picture.

To eliminate the caption and quilt story, click the button on the icon row with a lower case "i". You will then be able to see the entire quilt picture. If you want to see the cap on of story, click the "i" button and they will re appear.

If you click the button on the bottom row with the forward-facing arrowhead, the button icon will change to a double line and the quilts will be displayed without you having to click

on the forward arrow located to the right. To stop the display changes, click on double line button, and the display will not move forward again unless you click the forward arrow button.

If you are looking at one quilt picture and want to look at another quilt picture from the group, you can click on the small version of the quilt picture and it will be displayed.

If you want to look at a part of the quilt picture in more detail, position your cursor on the area of the quilt that you want to examine – a window will appear to the right with a magnification of the quilt image.

Finally, if you want to go back the search page , click on the grey icon with an x in the upper right hand corner, and you will be taken back o that page.
