2001 Fern's Creatures from Drunkard's Path by Hope Rice ~ 39 x 57

My granddaughter Fern's first quilt. Creatures were made with traditional Drunkard's Path squares. Find the bear, ladybug, inchworm, lobster, two fish, cat, snail, turtle, dog, cat, two butterflies, hedgehog, whale, toucan, shrimp, jellyfish, duck and penguin. Inktense pens were used for creatures' details. The back is Minky fabric. Machine pieced. Domestic machine quilted. Original design.

2002 On the Farm by Beth Aversa ~ 37 x 45

I enjoy making charm quilts and have used this pattern previously. I quilted it using free motion quilting and my all time favorite, quilting templates or rulers. Machine pieced. Domestic machine quilted. Design source: Book. Design credit: Three Times a Charm by Me and My Sister Designs.

2003 Little Hooter by Linda Dills ~ 30 x 40

This has 75 colors of Kona cotton solid fabrics and 697 pieces. Machine pieced. Longarm machine quilted. Design credit: Michael O'Dell pattern. First place.

2004 Marvel Comics by Laurel Blaine ~ 54 x 78

Fussy cut and arranged to look like comic book pages focusing on Marvel Comics across several lines. It took several years to collect the necessary fabric to ensure a wide representation of characters from Fantastic Four to X-Men to the Avengers. (Instagram: Comfortably.Nerdy) Machine pieced. Longarm machine quilted. Original design.

2005 Fala and Victory Quilt Blocks by Brenda Thorsen ~ 58 x 70

The blocks were started in 2009. The fabric was received monthly from Gathering Fabrics, Woodinville, Washington. Machine pieced. Hand and machine appliquéd. Longarm machine quilted by Gerry Schmidt. 2006 Ring Around the Rosie by Mary Ann Johnson ~ 42 x 65

I found this kit at an antique shop in Port Orchard. It is hand embroidered and hand quilted. I enjoy working with items from the 1930's and 1940's. Hand quilted. Second place.

2007 Happy Little Kitties by Carol Weber ~ 51 x 51

Just a little "easy peasy" to rest from the "big girl" project. Machine pieced. Domestic machine quilted. Design source: Commercial pattern.

2008 Jurassic Quilt by Marian Floyd ~ 78 x 99

My six-year-old grandson loves dinosaurs and these dinosaurs are so impressive! I got pretty tired of outlining all these palm trees and dinosaurs! Machine pieced. Domestic machine quilted. Design source: Kit by Jason Yenter of In the Beginning.
